## Measuring a basic window.

## Recording your measurements.

Always measure at three points for the height and the width of the window for a more accurate measurement, make sure you record the smallest measurement from both the width and the height.

When measuring inside the recess take measurements from wall to wall and ceiling to sill to get a blind that will fit nicely into your recess, take a top middle and bottom measurement for the width and then a left middle and right measurement for the drop (height) record the smallest measurement from both the hight and the width data.
